The Clark County Historical Society cordially invites you to utilize our facilities at the Heritage Center in downtown Springfield during the coming year.

In addition to a Research Library, Archives, and meeting rooms, the Center features a state-of-the-art museum with permanent exhibits in seven galleries, including the new Exposition Hall. Within the permanent exhibits are meeting areas where students may view films on the Shawnee, Battle of Piqua and early Clark County as well as participate in discussions or group activities.

School tours, lasting 1½ to 2 hours, may be scheduled Tuesdays through Friday and are *free of charge*. All tours are customized to fit the curriculum needs and time constraints of individual teachers. Emphasis is placed upon meeting multiple academic content standards for Social Studies, as well as components of English language arts, mathematics, and science. We welcome your visits and look forward to serving area students, educators, and families.
